Think before you click: **do not open links you receive from strangers** through e-mails or that take you to websites you don't know.

If you see **images or videos not suitable** for your age, let an adult know straight away.

Let an adult help you with **setting up the right security** and privacy settings on your smartphone, tablet and within apps.
